UK patents, trade marks and designs

No Change





European patents

No Change





European trade marks

No longer extended to the UK

But HM Gov. will...

- automatically create cloned UK registrations (no official fees)
- give 9 months to file a clone UK application (official fees payable)
- licenses automatically extended too





International trade marks based on EUTMs

No Change

But to apply Post-Brexit...

- You will need a UK base application/registration; or
- Be a national/domiciled/business in EU to use an EUTM as a base application






European Registered designs

No longer extended to the UK

But HM Gov. will...

- automatically create cloned UK registrations (no official fees)
- give 9 months to file a clone UK application (official fees payable)
- licenses automatically extended too





European Unregistered designs

No longer extended to the UK

But HM Gov. will...

- automatically create Continuity Unregistered Designs
- Introduce Supplementary Unregistered Designs





Exhaustion of Rights – Importing from the EEA

No Immediate Change

IP on Goods sold in the EU, after Brexit, will be considered exhausted in the UK

Parallel imports of genuine goods from the EEA to the UK will be unaffected





Exhaustion of Rights – Exporting to the EEA

May be restricted

IP on Goods sold in the UK, after Brexit, will not be considered exhausted in the EEA

Export to EEA may present an infringement risk





What do you need to do?

- Act on EU TM / RCD applications
- Check licenses have no special provisions
- Notify licensees
- If you export check permission with the EU rights holder
- If in doubt contact your IP advisor

Otherwise it is business as usual
